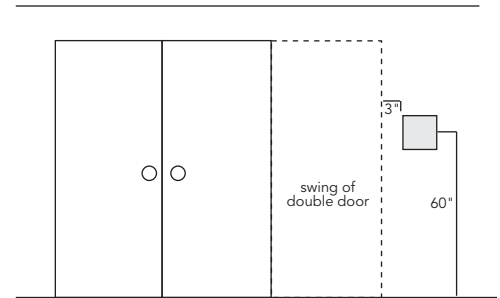
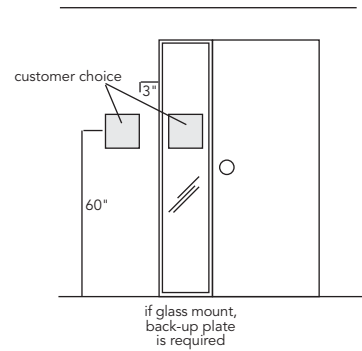
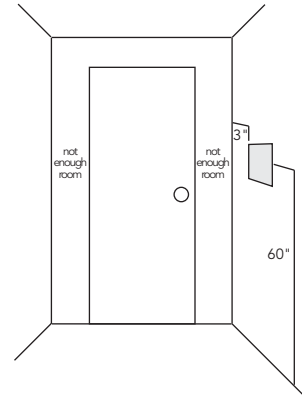
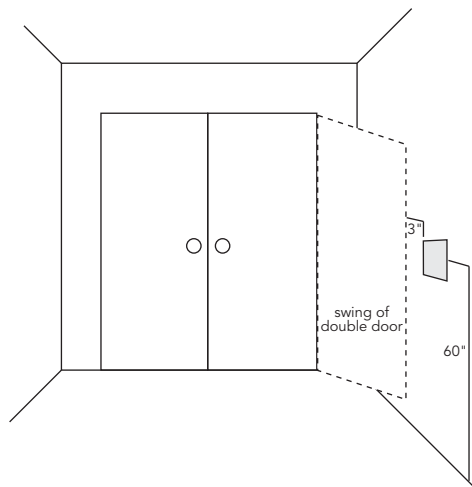
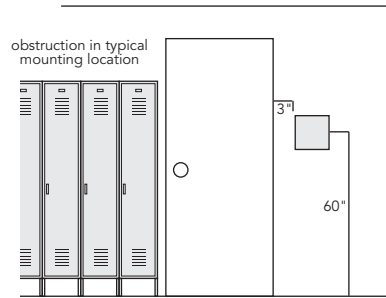
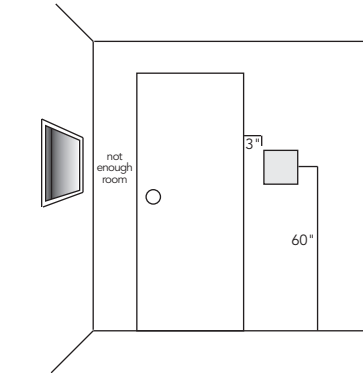
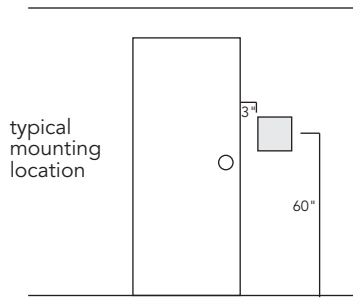




ADA MOUNTING DEFINITIONS



Mounting Notes.

ADA signs are typically wall mounted on the door handle side, 3" off door jamb, 60" above floor level (AFL) to the center-point of the sign.

In certain situations (e.g. ELEMENTARY SCHOOLS), height AFL may, at owners choice, be changed to 48" .

If there is not enough room, mount on closest adjacent wall, 3" clear of obstructions, protruding objects or swing of double doors.

If glass panels are next to the door, the customer should advise if the signs will be installed on glass (may dictate an additional back-up panel) or adjacent wall.

In circumstances when none of the options above apply, use your best judgement.

Signs mounted on doors are not ADA acceptable.
